

Information about the xlsx file:

 - =▶ **Info 3 List INVENT Stamps (+flyers & Philanews) compl (J1849-present)**

The stamp lists have been created to make it easy to classify stamps, etc. from your collection.

The lists are designed to do the following:

▶(only fill in cells with a light green background colour without removing security)

for the individual lists:

- Classify stamps and related items
- Classify the flyers & Philanews (digital & physical)
- Use auto-filter
- If an inventory is entered incorrectly, a warning will appear (?)

On the right-hand side, there are columns for:

- € entries (values to be removed or not, as required).
- Flyers or Philanews lists (digital and physical inventory)

▶(only when security is disabled: go to 'check' - 'disable security sheet' -> is password-free)

- Insert rows/copy with formulas - Insert sheet row(s) - copy previous row with formulas - paste
The formulas **in the blue header rows** adjust automatically.
- Columns can be inserted as needed for items not included in these lists.
- At the bottom of the page "**Info 3a Y1848-Y1954 (1-960)**" (from row 2551) there are recovery rows in case of damage or incorrect formulas.

It is up to you whether you want to secure the sheet with or without a password.

These inventory lists are divided into several parts:

Info 3a Y1849-Y1954 (1-1960)
Info 3b Y1955-Y1988 (961-2792a)
Info 3c Y1999-Y2009 (2793-3982)
Info 3d Y2010-Y2019 (3983-4896)
Info 3e Y2020-Y2029 (4897-5...)
... and then future issues...
