- From N° 1046 of Y1958 to N°. 1315/1317 of Y1965 (Ghent Flower show III) ... "flyers" are NOT numbered: they are in this list marked with "nn°" (NO numbering) ... but with a "on°" (tracking number) according to the order of the catalog numbers.
- The data NOT listed in these "flyers / Philanews" are visible in *italics*: they are ... obtained from other sources (correct or not).
- The "size" - from "flyer 3/60" ► N° 1128 - shown in parentheses (..) are the actual ... sizes of the stamps but NOT listed in the "flyers".
