Multiples for international franking

Multiple franking is now also available for foreign correspondence

According to Bpost, the franking of multiples for national shipments is a success: it is more transparent and can be used indefinitely. Since 01/01/2009, they are also available for international shipments. The system has been simplified since 02/2008 by removing "prior" mailings.

- domestic: numbers surrounded by circles
 - foreigner: square cubes
- Europe = European flag, rest of the world = with globe symbol

It means:

-  Standardized shipping within the borders of Europe 0 - 50gr
-  Non-standard shipping in Europe 0 - 100gr
-  Standardized shipping outside Europe 0 - 50gr
-  Non-standard shipping outside Europe 0 - 100gr
