According to data in **Philanews No. 2 / 2012 (p. 14)** this would be bpost's first issue with an FSC certificate. (FSC stands for Forest Stewardship Council and means that the paper used for the stamps comes from sustainably managed forests. The certificate also means that bpost can guarantee that the whole process - from the wood in the forests to the production of the paper to the use paper in the seal printing sector - according to strict FSC standards).

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Remark

This is apparently correct for this Stamps from booklet **B132** with "P-P6a Self-adhesive layer applied to the backing paper", but unfortunately not for other types of paper. - On 14/05/2011 (No. **4125/4159** - **Philanews No. 3 / 2011 (p. 23)**) a series has already been released with paper "Gummed Versatile Lithograph with FSC"
- Also on 04/14/2012 (No. **4230/4239** - **Philanews No. 2 / 2012 (p. 10)**) a stamps from booklet **B128** is issued with paper "Litho Polyvalent gummed with FSC - self-adhesive layer applied to the backing paper"
